Two convenient ordering options

Order Online:

Using Rain Barrel Water

- Water flowers, trees, shrubs, garden and lawn.
- Wash car, rinse tools, clean boots.
- Do not drink water from rain barrel.
- Do not cook or bathe with water from rain barrel.

Food grade barrels are washed and recycled to produce the rain barrels. The barrels have a screw top with large three inch holes that are covered with screen mesh to keep out debris and mosquitos. There are two male fittings, one for overflow (at the top), and one for attaching additional barrels (near the bottom). Also included is a spigot with valve for controlled filling of buckets, or attaching a hose to water plants.

Rain Barrel Instructions

- Place your barrel on a flat, stable platform (concrete blocks, landscaping blocks, or other solid support). The added height increases the water pressure and allows you to put a bucket or watering can under the spigot to deliver water to your plants.
 - Install an overflow hose to direct water away from your house foundation for times of high rainfall.
 - Keep your rain barrel lid tight at all times to prevent children, animals, and insects from entering or falling in.
 - Measure and cut the downspout. Use your existing elbow or purchase a flexible spout attachment to direct the water to the top of the barrel. The end of the downspout should be cut 6-8 inches above the top of the barrel. Downspouts can be cut with a hacksaw, or sawzall with a metal cutting blade.
 - In fall, empty your rain barrel and leave the valve (spigot) open. Remove the cap on the lower fitting. Leave the barrel in place and in the spring just close the valve and install the cap.
 - Diverter are available that can easily switch the downspout from filling the barrel to normal operation once the barrel is full.
- ***Caution*** A full 55 gallon rain barrel weighs about 450 pounds.
